ACCOMODATIONS

A Personal Care Attendant (PCA) may ride with you at no extra cost. A PCA is someone who travels with a rider that is unable to travel alone. COAST is not responsible for providing PCAs. Please let us know if your PCA will be riding with you when scheduling your ride. This will ensure that there is space in the vehicle for your PCA to ride with you.

Our agency buses and vans can accommodate your wheelchair or power scooter. Please call us for specifications/sizing.

Service animals will also be accommodated. A service animal is any guide dog, signal dog or other animal (ex. miniature horse) individually trained to work or perform specific tasks for an individual with a disability.
